How do we cater for mother-tongue language learning at CCC?


We support mother-tongue learning through resources in the library, translating texts, multilingual teaching staff, tutorial groups and a growing and invested parent community.

What is the Language Profile and Language of Instruction at CCC?

CCC has a diverse cultural catchment with students from over 60 cultures. 40% of residents were born overseas, 30% non-English speaking backgrounds and 30% of the population have Asian cultural heritage. The most significant cultural groups are Chinese, Taiwanese, Indian and Middle Eastern communities. English is the predominant language and the language of instruction.
