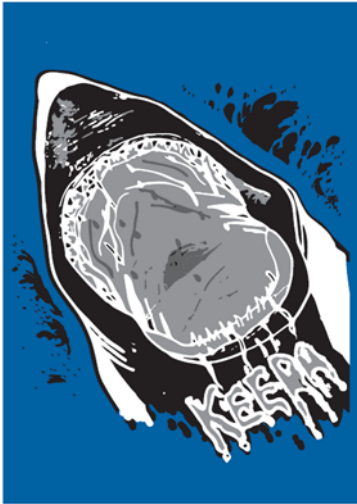


Ms Dajana Zec
